The Bristol, Maine resident began his college career in September with four consecutive birdies and a 66 in the Griffin Invitational in Petersburg, Va. He won the 2023 New England Boys Championship as a high school junior and captured two Hurricane Junior Tour events – the 2025 54-Hole LPGA Junior Open in May at Daytona Beach, Fla., and the 2024 54-Hole Carolinas Junior Open in North Carolina on the Hurricane Junior Tour.

The student at Ontario's Blyth Academy shot 66 last spring in pre-qualifying for the PGA Tour's Cognizant Classic in south Florida and 72 in the qualifier. Career goal is the PGA Tour or to become a pharmaceuticals sales representative.

Brubaker, 18, is a senior on the Ponte Vedra High School golf team who plays out of Marsh Landing Country Club. Brubaker has committed to play at Colgate next fall.
